We are at such a critical stage of human history that the responsibility of reversing these losses are on our shoulders. Any delay in dealing with this task would lead to an irreversible erosion of biological resources pushing the very survival of mankind to a tipping point.

Obviously, we need to act immediately to take stock of the status of our forests and biological resources and find measures to conserve them. In this direction we intend to provide a discussion platform to all those who are engaged in assessing, documenting, utilizing and conserving forest resources. Befittingly, this is proposed to be undertaken through a two-day seminar on 9th and 10th of March 2011 – the international year of forests. The seminar would bring together scholars, policy makers, and managers working towards documentation, utilization and conservation of forests and bio-resources.
