Byrraju Foundation (BF), a not-for-profit (non-governmental organization) was set up in July 2001 to bring in improvement in quality of life in villages, is dedicated to rural transformation. Its interventions include Health, Education, Adult Literacy, Water, Environment, Sanitation, Livelihoods, Agri-advisory Services, Disability Rehabilitation and Women Empowerment, covering 193 villages spread over 6 districts in Andhra Pradesh (AP), impacting a million lives.

In the water area, BF is working to transform the drinking water situation by providing solutions appropriate to local conditions, cost effective and replicable. Towards this, BF has setup 56 communitybased water plants producing pure water, jointly supported by Gram Panchayat, community and BF, conforming to World Health Organisation guidelines. allowing access to safe water to all sections of community in 175 villages with 850,000 people, on sustainable basis. This initiative lead to improved health of villagers, consequent enhancement of productivity, economic sustainability of plants, with surplus generated being used for village development. A few agencies, including United Nations Human Settlement Programme (UN-HABITAT), replicated this model, with in and outside AP, in 15 locations benefiting a lakh of people. The work, received a few notable recognitions:

- ▶ 'Outstanding Display' in 95th Indian Science Congress, Visakhapatnam, January 2008
- ▶ 'Best Water NGO-Water Quality' in India for years 2006-07 and 2007-08 by Water Digest and UNESCO
- ➤ Full Life Cycle Leader (Water) was conferred 'AP Scientist Award-2007' by AP Council of Science and Technology, Government of AP
