#### Note 7 Academic qualifications and experience

- Your application will only be assessed if it is accompanied by certified copies of academic transcripts for all of the courses you have undertaken to date. See the 'Application process' section of the Prospectus.

Course outlines and descriptions must be in English; if not, please include certified official English language translations.
