COURSE 1:

ONE YEAR Post Graduate Diploma in Environmental Sanitation Science

Job opportunities: Many opportunities in government, private and NGOs sectors viz. government public health departments/ railways/ municipal corporations/ airports/town panchayats and industries. The qualified professionals can work as a health inspectors, sanitary inspectors and public health workers as above mentioned departments.

The course is designed with a lot of practical training in classroom and field.

Eligibility: A pass in B.Sc., Chemistry or B.Sc., Food Technology from recognized Universities. The upper age limit is 28 years. The courses are offered for both males and females, and the medium of instruction is English. Exams will be in semester pattern.



COURSE 2:

ONE YEAR Certificate Course on Capacity Building for Health Workers

Jobs opportunities: In NGOs, and Government departments as general Health Workers, Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA), Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM), Anganwadi workers (AWW).

Eligibility: A pass in +2 (HSC) The upper age limit is 23 years.

Those with an aptitude for service, NGO staff can apply. The courses are offered for both males and females, and the medium of instruction is English. Exams will be in non-semester pattern



SCHOLARSHIPS/PLACEMENT:

Partial/full financial support for selected candidates, who having very good academic records and with financial constraints. Efforts to arrange for student placement are under way.
