Chamber recognizes water sanitation and recycling is major concern in maintaining the quality of environment and especially in achieving environmentally sound and sustainable development of our country.

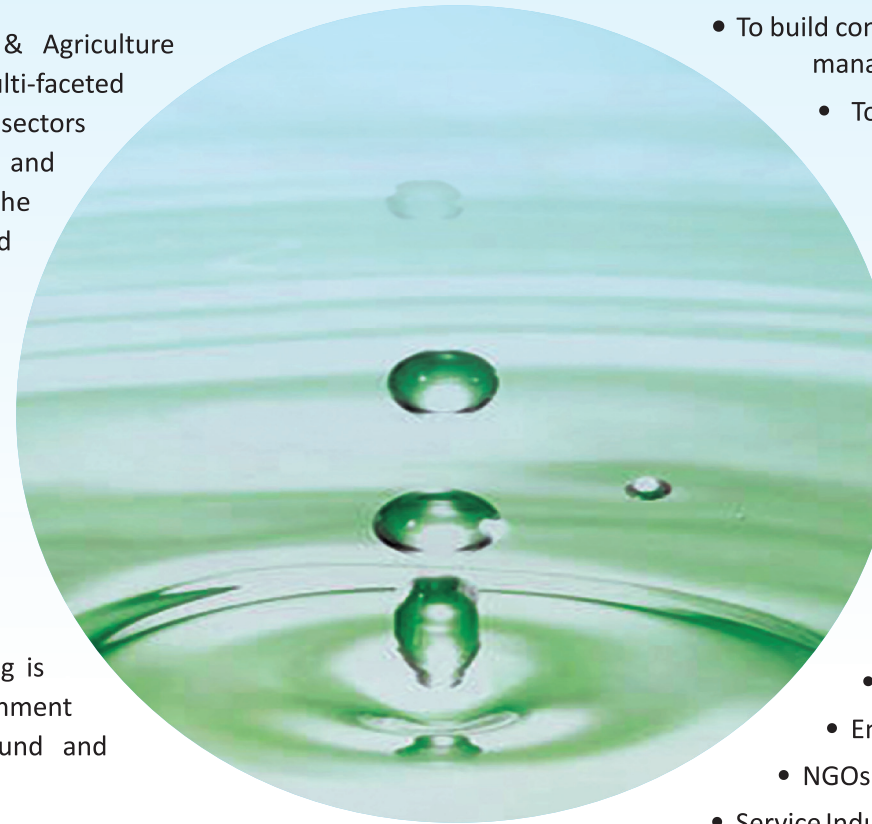
