Ensuring Water Security in Changing Environment Scenario for Water Professionals of Cluster Countries

November 26-27, 2015

A regional capacity development workshop on 'Ensuring Water Security in Changing Environment Scenario for Water Professionals of Cluster Countries' is being organized by Indian Institute of Technology Bombay, National Institute of Hydrology Regional Centre Bhopal and National Institute of Technology Hamirpur with support of UNESCO New Delhi Office.

The workshop is being organized in consonance with the UNESCO's IHP (International Hydrological Programme) devoted to water research, water resources management, and education and capacity building. IHP is an internationally coordinated hydrological research programme encompassing, holistic approach to facilitate education and capacity building, and to enhance water resources management and governance. IHP facilitates an interdisciplinary and integrated approach to watershed and aquifer management, which incorporates the social dimension of water resources, and promotes and develops international research in hydrological and freshwater sciences. UNESCO has launched its new eight-year Medium-term Strategy (2014-2021), the eighth phase of IHP (IHP-VIII) which aims to improve water security in response to local, regional, and global challenges. IHP-VIII aims to bring innovative methods, tools and approaches into play, by capitalizing on advances in water sciences, as well as building competences to meet the challenges of today's global water challenge through the proposed Regional Capacity Development Workshop.

During the Two Day Regional Capacity Development Workshop, eminent resource persons from Bhutan, Bangladesh, Maldives, Nepal, Sri Lanka and India shall deliberate on different aspects of water security. There will be a keynote on introduction to water security, its importance and framework followed by talks on its present status, challenges and way forward in each cluster country; linkage/ nexus in water-food-energy-climate-sustainability security; issues of concern for achieving water security; policy requirement to address water security challenges worldwide; participation of international water community in understanding water security and the need for action plans for achieving the same; water crisis, conflicts and gender issues; international best practices in water treatment to provide high-quality effluent and enhance recycling to reduce the pressure on freshwater resources; participation of stakeholders in the water treatment infrastructure; urban flooding and draughts in rural areas as ultimate challenge in water security. The exact agenda of workshop, however, shall be posted on website as well as all participants will be informed through their emails.

PARTICIPANTS SELECTION CRITERIA

- Participants and researchers involved in water resources, water sciences, water governance, water security, environmental sustainability, environmental engineering, environmental sciences at Post Graduate levels at the premier institutions and those involved in decision making in these subject matters from government departments, non-governmental organizations, consultancy firms and Industries are eligible to attend the workshop.
