As part of its ongoing program the field visits will be arranged to gain the practical knowledge about the various issues.

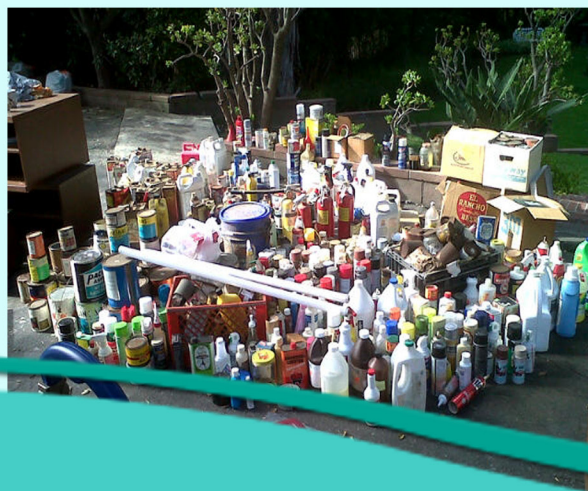
