IRRIGATION BY DIFFERENT SOURCES

DISTRICT: BUNDI

Bundi district has total geographical area 5550 sq.km. The area under irrigation is 2273.68 sq.km. which is about 40.96 per cent of the total geographical area of the district. The principal source of irrigation in the district are canals, wells and tanks. The canals are the major source of irrigation in the district. Some of the major irrigation project of the district are Gudha, Bundi-ka-Gothra, Pech-ki-Baori, Paivapura, Talwas and Bhilmet. The first three storage tanks are Hindoli tehsil while Paivapura & Talwas dams are located in Nainwa and Bhilmet dam in Bundi tehsil of the district. The district has prominent rivers viz. Chambal, Mej, Mangli, Eias, Talua etc.
