As India fights the Covid-19, **Millions of poor labourers are struggling to access food and rations during the COVID lockdown to keep themselves and their families safe.**

These are the people who are at most risk of severe ill-health and death due to starvation. There are sections of the population that live on the edge even in times of apparent “normalcy”. When faced with a crisis like the Corona induced lockdown, it is they who are the most likely to fall off the edge.

We are **providing ration kits to labourers, slum dwellers, and migrant workers and have already reached to over 12,000 families in and around Mumbai**

Wheat Flour- 5kg
Pulses- 2kg
Oil-2 liters
Sugar- 5 kg
Salt- 1 kg
This kit costs Rs 1000
