IRRIGATION BY DIFFERENT SOURCES

DISTRICT: JAISALMER

Jaisalmer district has total geographical area i.e. 38401 sq.km. The area under irrigation is 238.95 sq.km. which is about 0.62 per cent of the total geographical area of the district. Under the existing conditions in the district, absence of perennial streams, and wells too deep to be economically utilised for irrigation purposes, artificial irrigation on any significant scale, is impracticable. The main source of irrigation in the district is canals. There does not exists any major or medium irrigation project in the district however some minor irrigation projects exist in the district they are 12 in Pokaran and 29 in Jaisalmer tehsil.
