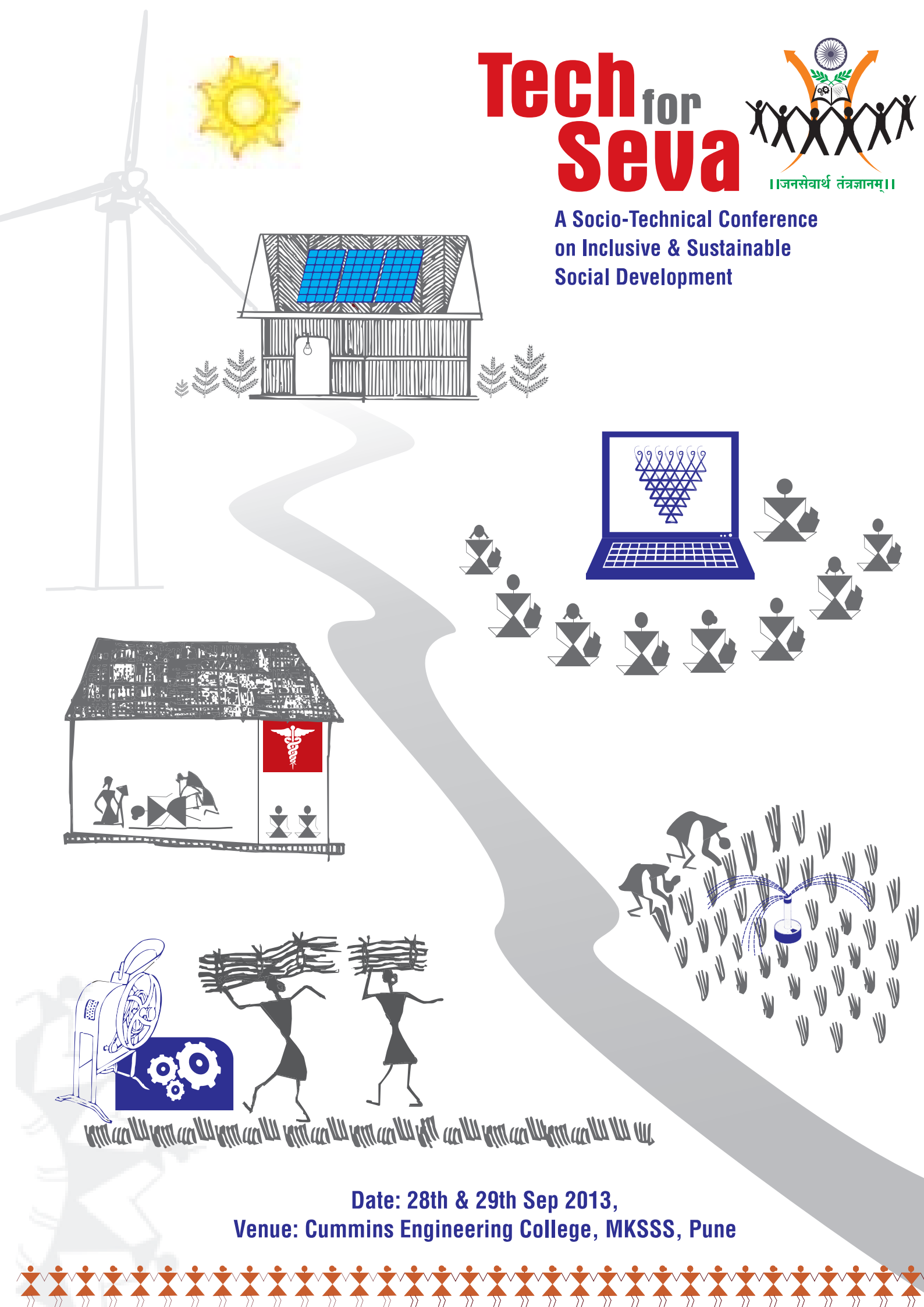


# Tech for Seva

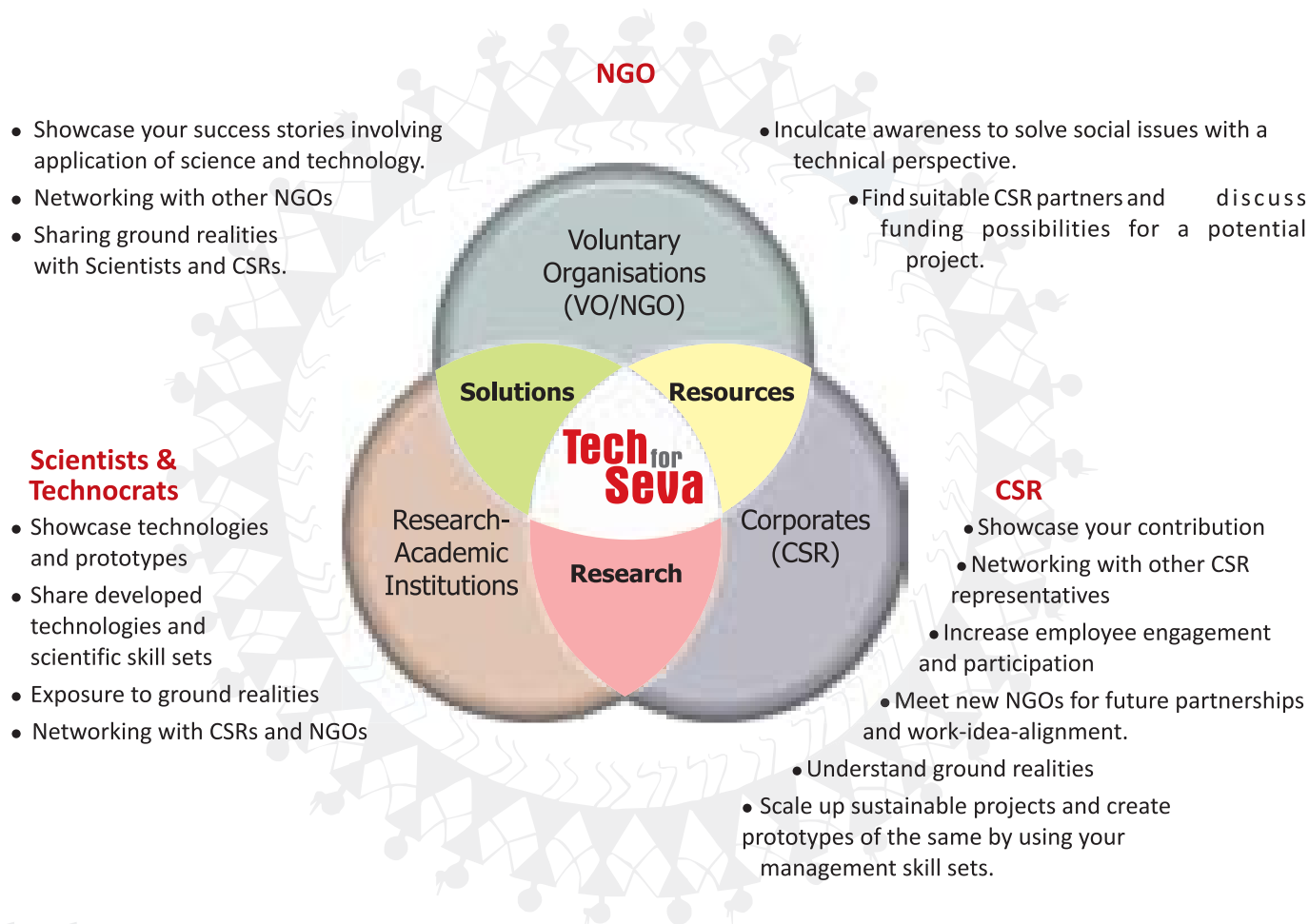
