Freshwater is running out in India. This trend is going to continue with the growth in country's population, increased water consumption levels for domestic, industrial, and agricultural usage, and climate change becoming a reality. In recent years, many business initiatives have been developed across the world to support sustainable water management. Many companies have improved their water management in their direct operations and through their supply chains. Some have set water-use targets, assist suppliers with water-efficiency practices, and partner with governments, policy makers and community groups to address water shortages and sanitation, and to share experiences with the ultimate aim of advancing best practices in the field. In India, the industry initiatives in the context of water management have been in the areas of (a) policy formulation, (b) information dissemination, water audits, and water awareness, and (c) water projects which involve promoting private sector participation and watershed management, and d) attitudinal and awareness drives like water audits. This webinar will highlight the success stories of private businesses in India. They will share their approach, challenges and lessons learnt.
